Worked with Lucas County producers to implement best management practices on thousands of acres through the H2Ohio Phosphorus Reduction Program. The District also worked with the County Engineer on ditch maintenance projects.



Reached tens of thousands of people county-wide through school and general public programs (in-person and virtual), office sales, District Newsletter, social media, and our website.



Partnered with local, state, and federal agencies to represent Soil & Water and participate in on-the-ground efforts for natural resource conservation in Lucas County.



Sold approximately 10,600 native trees, shrubs, and forbs in annual sales. Through a partnership with Rain Garden Initiative and Sacred Grounds Toledo, 2 rain gardens were installed and 2 pollinator gardens were planted in the community.


