ate way to dip the bundle of trees in the Terrasorb mixture and bag them, being careful to leave no roots exposed. The extra unclaimed trees have found good homes through the Clay High School grounds as well as the teachers when needed.

The perch that Charlie raises in the tanks in the agricultural center are purchased through the District's fish fingerling sale in the fall. Charlie and a group of students from Clay High School also participated in the pilot Lead and Line clean-up in Spring 2005 where they collected lead and fishing line out of the Maumee River.
