## How To: Make a Critter Guard for your Rain Barrel



Do you....

 Live in an area where chipmunks or other small critters live <u>AND</u>
Have a rain barrel?

Then you should consider putting a critter guard on your overflow hose to prevent accidental drownings. It's easy and can be made with materials/tools typically found in the home.

<u>Materials:</u> Screen/Mesh/Chicken Wire; Zip-tie (at least 4" in length) <u>Tools:</u> Needle-nose Pliers; Drill with appropriate bit (optional)

<u>Step 1:</u> Cut your screen to a size just bigger than the end of the overflow hose. <u>Step 2:</u> Create two holes on opposite sides of the overflow hose. A drill and drill bit can be used to make the holes easily.

Step 3: Thread the zip-tie through the two holes.

<u>Step 4:</u> Secure the screen to the overflow hose using the zip-tie. Cut any excess zip-tie off.

<u>Step 5:</u> Re-attach overflow hose to rain barrel.
