

Blue Creek Conservation Area Farm Specifications for 2022

1. All inputs will be purchased by owner and delivered as contractor wishes.
2. The Agricultural Conservationist will be notified a minimum of 24 hours in advance of planting and harvesting.
3. The grain will be harvested at a moisture level acceptable to the Agricultural Conservationist.
4. The cropping rotation for the 2022 season will be followed by the contractor.
5. All crops will be planted by conservation operations (minimum 30% residue coverage on surface after planting or the planting of a cover crop) unless otherwise discussed with Agricultural Conservationist. Failure to plant in a timely manner may be cause for the Board of Supervisors to reduce rate of pay per acre.
6. If the annual payment adds up to be more than \$10,000.00, a Lucas County Affidavit in Compliance with O.R.C. Section 3517.13 will be required to be signed by the contractor.
7. For spreading of the finished compost, owner will estimate cubic yards in the static pile. Payment will be paid on this cubic yard estimate to be spread.
8. Payment will be for 33 acres of corn and 37 acres of soybeans unless the entire field is not completed.
